

Porcelain Paving

Cleaning

Thanks to its hardness and weather-resistance, porcelain paving tiles can be cleaned with almost any detergent. However, we recommend simply using a stiff broom and water and if necessary, a mild detergent. For greater convenience and to avoid potential limescale deposits forming, we recommend facilitating drainage with a rubber brush.

How often should I clean my patio?

Regular washing and brushing should be enough to keep your paving in pristine condition.

Can I use an acid based cleaner?

We do not recommend this type of cleaner. Jointing materials may potentially stain/change colour when directly exposed to acid based cleaners. We recommend testing on a small discreet area first.

Can I use a pressure washer to clean my patio?

We do not recommend the regular use of jet/power washers as this may affect the surface of the product or the grouting over time.

Can I use salt to de-ice my paving?

No, because during freezing and thawing conditions, the use of salt can affect both the durability and the look of the paving. You should use a plastic shovel or stiff brush to remove snow and ice.

Sealing your paving

Sealants are not necessary for your porcelain paving.
